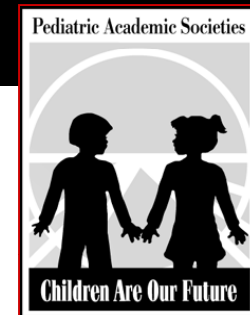

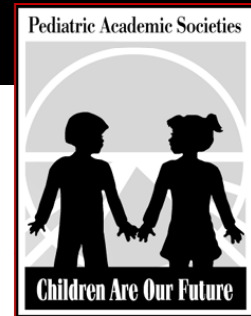

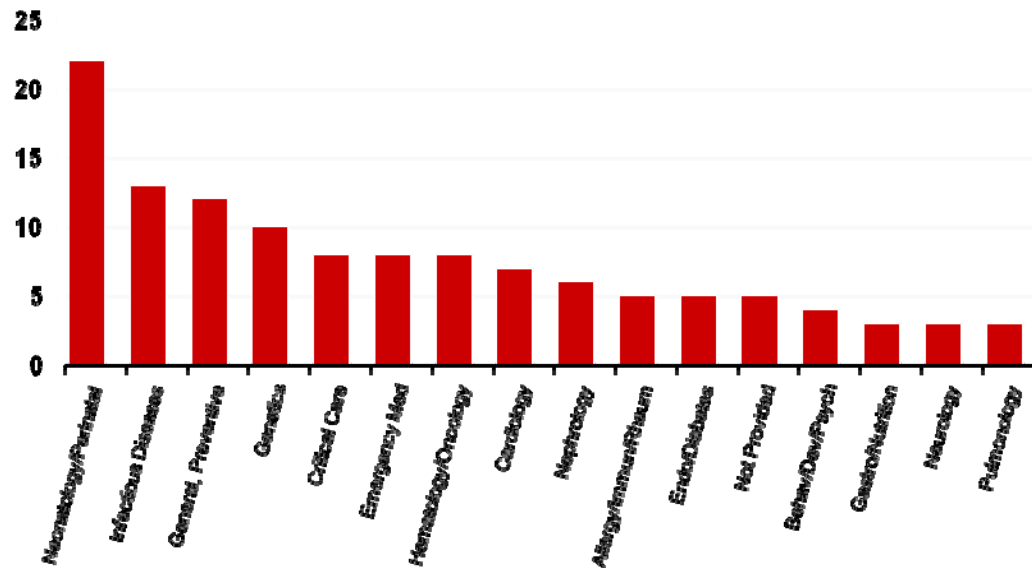

Based on 131 Subspecialties listed for 128 New Members



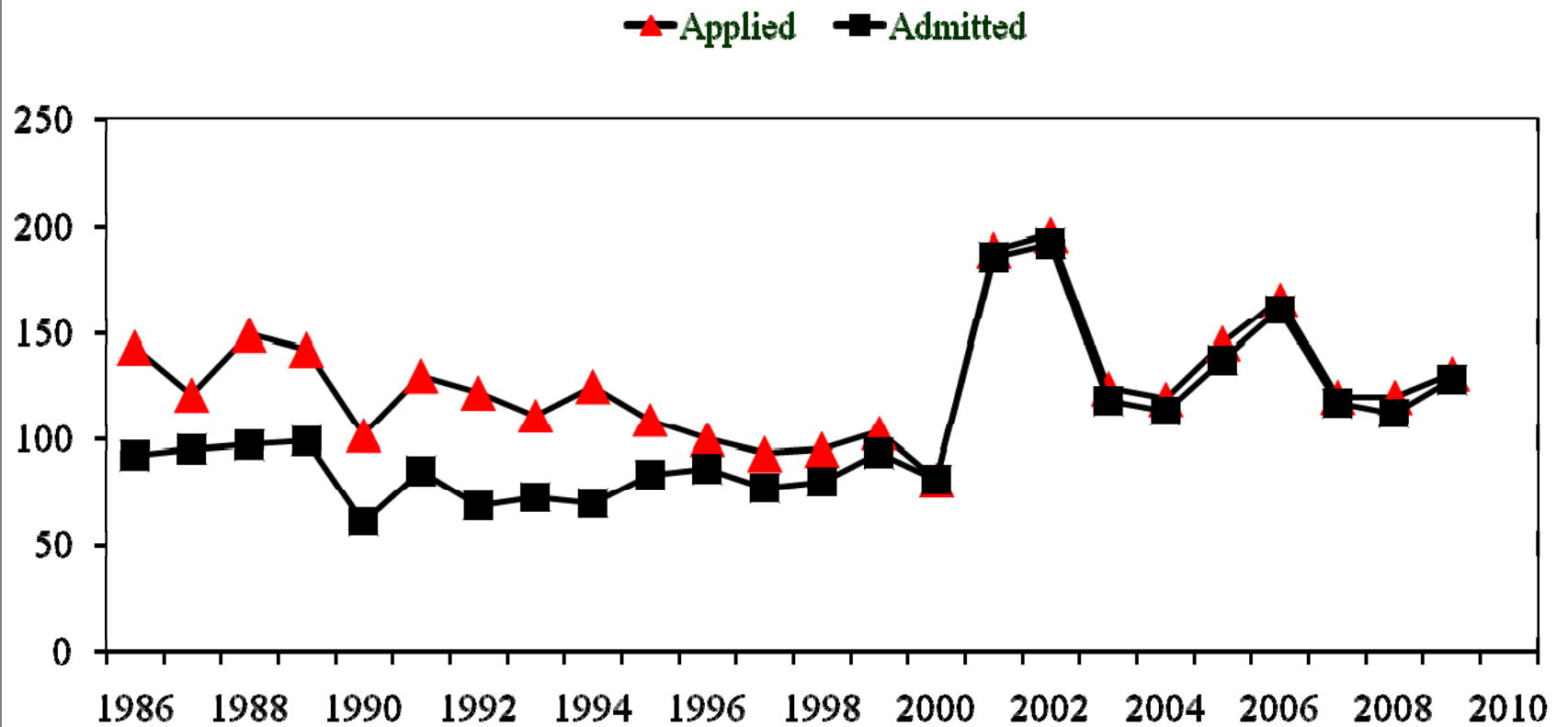
